### "Helping Profession" Scholarship Guidelines

\$500 scholarship provided to a student entering into an accredited post-secondary institution in the field of, but not limited to; policing, nursing, social work, justice studies, firefighter, counselling, military service, medical field, etc...

#### **Eligibility**

- Be a resident of Langford, Colwood, View Royal, Highlands, Metchosin, Songhees First Nation or Esquimalt First Nation
- Be graduating from High School
- Enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution; or will be enrolling within 1 year of graduating High School
- Extra consideration will be given to students that have experience in community service or volunteerism

#### **Application**

- The applicant must submit a copy of their most recent transcript.
- The applicant must provide 2 letters of reference (non-familial).
- The applicant must submit a one page letter or video explaining why they should receive the scholarship.

### "Full Potential" Scholarship Guidelines

#### Awarded to an individual in recognition of their ability to overcome adversity.

(Examples of adversity can include but are not limited to: death of a parent, disability, drug or alcohol addiction, leaving a gang, mental health issues, overcoming bullying, etc...)

\$1000 scholarship provided to a student entering into an accredited post-secondary institution.

#### **Eligibility**

- Be a resident of Langford, Colwood, View Royal, Highlands, Metchosin, Songhees First Nation or Esquimalt First Nation
- Be graduating from High School
- Enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution; or will be enrolling within 1 year of graduating High School
- Extra consideration will be given to students that have experience in community service or volunteerism

#### **Application**

- Application can be applied for by the student or on behalf of a student (i.e. a counsellor, coach, parent, friend can apply on the students behalf)
- The applicant must provide 2 letters of references, one may be familial
- The applicant must submit a one page letter or video explaining why the student should receive the scholarship; highlighting the adversity that the student has overcome. The example should be fairly recent (e.g. the last 4 years)
- The applicant may submit a copy of their most recent transcript
